

RESOLUTION NO. 22-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULF BREEZE, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR OCTOBER 1, 2016, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2017, BUDGET TO MAKE CERTAIN AMENDMENTS TO APPROPRIATIONS OF CITY FUNDS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, per Florida Statutes Section 166.241, the adopted budget may be revised with a budget amendment approved by City Council in the same manner in which the budget was adopted. The resolution adopting the annual budget allows the budget to be amended by resolution provided that a corresponding funding source supports any additional expense. Transfers between funds and increases to a fund's total budget are permitted by resolution adopted by City Council. The budget amendment increases or decreases the total amount of the adopted budget of each fund.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 26-16 adopted on September 19, 2016, authorizes the initial Fiscal Year 2017 budgets and amendments to the budget by resolution.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 22-17 is amendment number 5 to the Fiscal Year 2017 annual budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULF BREEZE, FLORIDA THAT:

Section 1. Gulf Breeze Financial Services Fund Amendment

The City expended \$35,000 more than budgeted for legal and professional services. Therefore, there is appropriated \$35,000 from Unencumbered Fund Balances.

Section 2. General Government Fund Amendment

The City expended \$325,000 more than budgeted for legal and professional services. Therefore, there is appropriated \$325,000 from Reserves Brought Forward.

Section 3. Red Light Fund

The City expended \$427,908.70 for an unbudgeted Pierce Saber fire engine as approved by the Council on July 3, 2017. Therefore, there is appropriated a transfer from the Red Light Fund to General Government Fund in the amount of \$427,908.70.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect upon its adoption by City Council immediately and shall be published as required by law.


