

SOUTH SANTA ROSA UTILITY SYSTEM  
RECLAIMED WATER AGREEMENT

The intent of this AGREEMENT is to identify and define practices for use of reclaimed irrigation water which protects human health and the environment and other practices as may be established from time to time by the state.

1. All applicable parts of the Florida Department of Environment Protection Rule 62-610 shall be adhered to by the customer named below (USER).
2. Appropriate warning signs shall be posted around the sites utilizing reclaimed water by the USER to designate the nature of the water and its non-potability. The signs shall be posted in accordance with the current FDEP rules and regulations.
3. The USER will also take all reasonable precautions, including signs and labeling, to clearly identify reclaimed water system to prevent inadvertent human consumption. The signs and labeling and their posting shall be in accordance with current FDEP rules and regulations.
4. NO above ground hose bibs (faucets) will be allowed to be connected to any pipe that contains reclaimed water.
5. Reclaimed water may NOT be used to fill swimming pools or hot tubs.
6. Bubbler or subsurface type irrigation system should be used around pool planters.
7. NO cross-connections shall be made between the reclaimed water system and potable water systems.
8. A buffer of 75 feet shall be maintained between the edge of the wetted area of the reclaimed water irrigation system application site and any existing or approved (but not yet constructed) potable water supply wells.
9. NO cross-connections shall be made between the reclaimed water system and wells, potable or non-potable. Non-potable wells used as backup to reclaimed water SHALL HAVE BACKFLOW PREVENTORS. User will notify and receive permission from the UTILITY and FDEP BEFORE a non-potable well is added as a back-up to a reclaimed water system.
10. The use of reclaimed water shall be consistent with the current FEDP's and other applicable regulatory agency rules and regulations.
11. This AGREEMENT shall remain intact as long as customer has a utility account with the City. A \$6.00 monthly service fee will be ADDED to the Utility bill. This fee is due whether the reclaimed water service is utilized or NOT.
12. User will be responsible for reclaimed water service line after the curb stop located in the meter box. SSRUS will maintain the service line from the water main to the curb stop.
