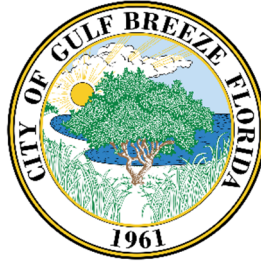


City of Gulf Breeze Municipal Youth Council



The purpose of the Gulf Breeze Municipal Youth Council is to promote civic engagement and prepare our youth for future community leadership by providing opportunities to learn about and understand municipal government operations and plan and implement community initiatives. This program was developed in partnership with Gulf Breeze High School's Interact Club.

Program Goals:

- ❖ *Shape youth programs, projects, and activities*
- ❖ *Equip youth with an understanding of municipal government*
- ❖ *Prepare youth to be engaged citizens and community leaders*
- ❖ *Educate youth on project planning, organizing, and implementation*

Membership Requirements:

- ❖ Open to juniors and seniors in the Gulf Breeze community
- ❖ Participants will be expected to attend and actively participate in one-hour weekly meetings throughout the program
- ❖ All applicants will be considered regardless of race, color, gender, national origin, or disability

Additional Information:

- ❖ Participating students will be eligible to receive community service hours for Florida Bright Futures
- ❖ Due to COVID-19, all meetings will be held virtually with optional in-person, socially distanced activities
- ❖ The ten-week pilot program is tentatively scheduled on **Wednesdays** from **4:00-5:00 PM** beginning March 24 through May 26
- ❖ Space is limited to 10 participants
