## **RESOLUTION 43-2021**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GULF BREEZE, FLORIDA TERMINATING THE STATE OF EMERGENCY RELATED TO HURRICANE IDA THAT WAS DECLARED UNDER RESOLUTION NO. 42-2021.

**WHEREAS,** the weather system first identified by the National Hurricane Center as Tropical Storm Ida escalated and came ashore on the Louisiana Gulf Coast on August 29, 2021, as a catastrophic category 4 hurricane; and

**WHEREAS**, on August 27, 2021, the Mayor of the City of Gulf Breeze, adopted Resolution 42-2021 declaring a local state of emergency to prepare for the storm, which could have shifted to the east and made landfall closer to the City; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Gulf Breeze experienced gusty winds and rain throughout Sunday and into Monday, August 30, 2021, the City did not sustain any significant damage and the threat of Hurricane Ida has passed; and

**WHEREAS,** the City has now completed its emergency operations related to Hurricane Ida and to post-storm recovery.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Mayor of the City of Gulf Breeze, under the authority granted by pursuant to Section 2-37 of the City Code of Ordinances, hereby resolves, finds, and declares that effective **August 31, 2021, 3:00 pm**, **CDT**, until further action by the Mayor or the City Council of the City of Gulf Breeze, as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULF BREEZE, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The above recitals are true and are incorporated herein
- 2. The state of emergency declared under Resolution No. 42-2021 is hereby terminated.
- 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
